Whereas closing and downsizing post offices, reducing post office hours, and eliminating door-to-door delivery will reduce service and eliminate thousands of jobs in communities throughout our country; and

Whereas Canada Post offers a public service that needs to be protected; and

Be it therefore resolved that the Corporation of the Township of Dubreuilville write a letter to the Minister responsible for Canada Post that calls on the government to reverse the changes to services announced by Canada Post and to look instead for ways to increase service and revenues in areas such as postal banking;

Be it further resolved that the Corporation of the Township of Dubreuilville ask the Federation of Canadian Municipalities to request that the federal government consult with the public about what kind of postal service they need before allowing Canada Post to make such major changes to public postal service.
