MATANE POST OFFICE AND DOOR-TO-DOOR MAIL DELIVERY – SUPPORT FOR CANADA POST EMPLOYEES

Considering that Canada Post is putting forward an action plan that provides for a restructuring of postal services and rates;

Considering that Canada Post has announced it intends to eliminate door-to-door delivery all across the country within five (5) years, starting in 2014;

Considering that the City of Matane is particularly concerned with the postal rate hikes in rural and remote areas and services received by an aging population and Canadian households that rely on door-to-door delivery;

Considering that these changes could result in the closure of the post office following implementation of such action plan, and that it will be more difficult to provide affordable postal services to the entire population in all regions;

And resolved unanimously by councillors

That the City of Matane support Canada Post employees at the Matane post office and oppose the Canada Post action plan in order to stop the possible closure of the local post office and ensure that the concerns of municipalities are taken into account in relation to door-to-door mail delivery.
