consulted before this announcement was made;

Whereas municipalities own and manage municipal public

right of way;

Whereas Canada Post needs to obtain municipal consent

before installing community mailboxes on municipal

property;

Whereas Canada Post's unilateral decision will

negatively affect regional economies in this country;

Whereas municipalities constitute the governments responsible at the

local level for many services;

Whereas municipalities must ensure that the public receive all the

necessary information regarding these services;
