DES MUNICIPALITÉS DU QUÉBEC HELD ON FEBRUARY 20, 2014
AT THE LÉVIS CONVENTION AND EXHIBITION CENTRE**

12. Canada Post: Door-to-door mail delivery in urban areas

Whereas	Canada Post announced in December 2013 that it was undertaking a major reform of its services;
Whereas	this reform will eliminate door-to-door mail delivery in urban areas over the course of the next five years;
Whereas	the Union des municipalités du Québec (UQM) was not consulted before this announcement was made;
Whereas	municipalities own and manage municipal public right of way;
Whereas	Canada Post needs to obtain municipal consent before installing community mailboxes on municipal property;
Whereas	Canada Post's unilateral decision will negatively affect regional economies in this country;
Whereas	municipalities constitute the governments responsible at the local level for many services;
Whereas	municipalities must ensure that the public receive all the necessary information regarding these services;
